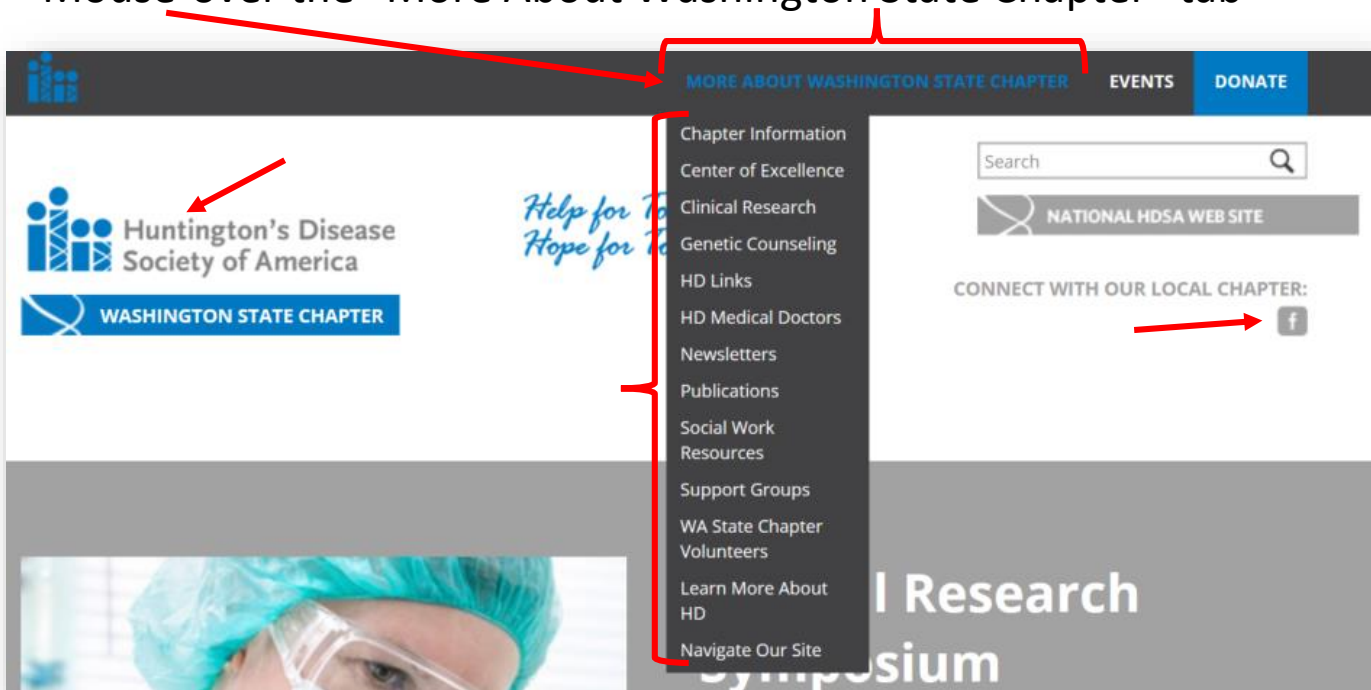

Clinical Trials

PRIDE-HD: Pridopidine	This Phase 2 clinical trial to evaluate safety and efficacy of 4 doses of pridopidine is now open for enrollment at Evergreen Neuroscience Center. Four different doses of the drug will be tested and compared with placebo. Former trials of this drug tested lower doses where benefit was shown in motor function. It is hoped that the higher doses in the present trial will give more benefit without increasing side effects.
In process, but no longer recruiting	This is a 12-month trial. Each participant has an 80% chance of getting active drug and a 20% chance of getting placebo. They have approval (if there are no safety issues) for participants to continue the drug after they complete the trial. Transportation will be paid for travel to and from Evergreen, which can include taxi or similar service.
	Criteria Include: Age 21 years or older, with early or middle stage HD, and not currently on another investigational drug or tetrabenazine. You may be on several (not all) antipsychotic and antidepressant drugs, but the dosage must be stable for at least 6 weeks. Must have a care-partner who can come to visits.

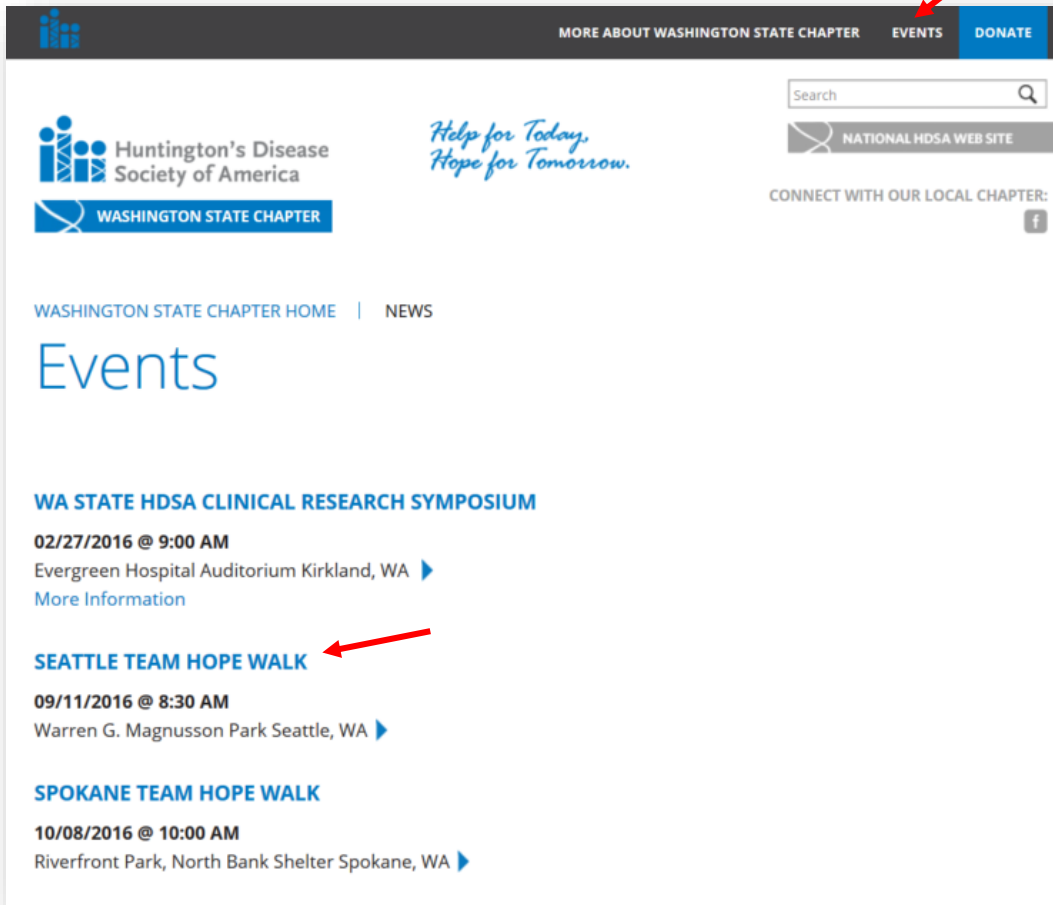

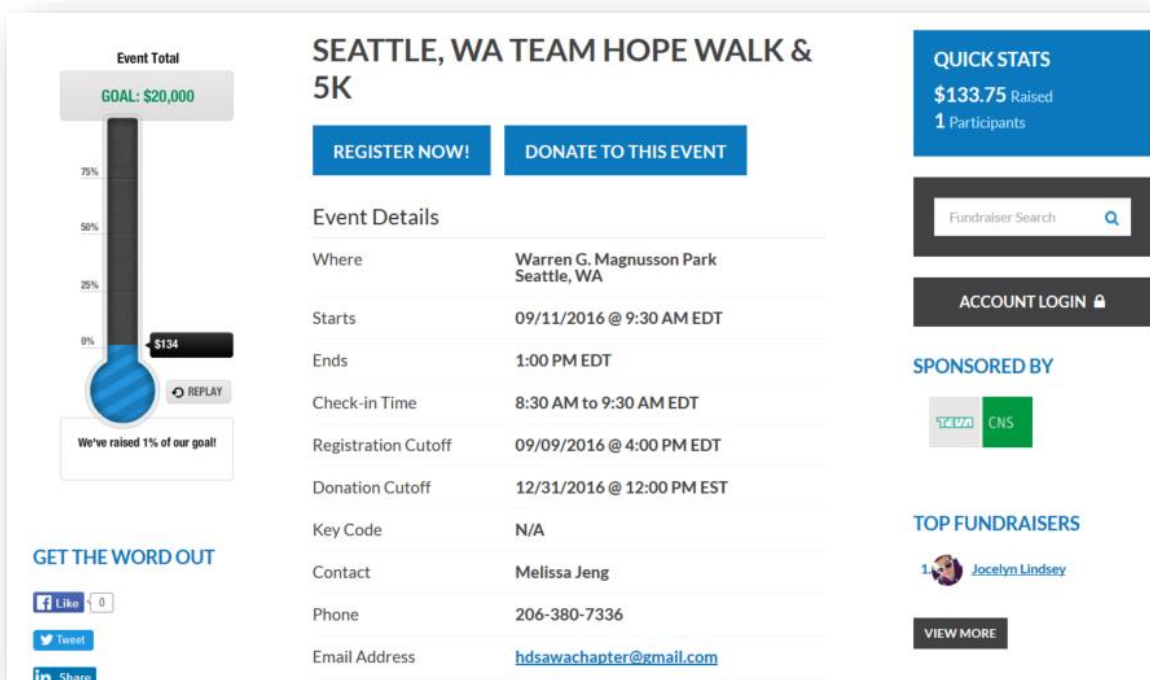
